FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM

The Family Self-Sufficiency program is a HUD voluntary program offered by the agency to help tenants achieve various goals to become financially independent. All Housing Choice Voucher and Public Housing head of household members are eligible for the program. Interested parties will meet with a FSS Specialist to create an Individual Training and Service Plan to develop education, training and employment goals in order to become financially independent. The program allows for participants in the program that incur a rent increase due to earned income to establish a savings (or escrow) account that can be accessed at the end of the program with successful completion of goals. Please contact us if you're interested in becoming independent from public assistance, exploring career options and gaining employment.
