- Northern Illinois Food Bank Meeting: On May 3rd, there was a meeting with the Northern Illinois Food Bank. They discussed the low funding for providing affordable internet.

### **Carandus Brown Provided an Update:**

- The government phone program for new sign-ups has been cut off. Comcast still offers the \$9.99 internet plan but no longer provides the \$50 credit. The program aims to assist those specifically in need.
- Ken is happy about the new hire, Calvin Wesley, and is developing new programs at the sites to get everyone on the same page and excited about living there.
- There is a trip to Walmart scheduled for tomorrow.
